<p>WHOLE SCHOOL TESTING Every student is tested in key literacy and numeracy areas to determine strengths and areas for further development. This information is used to design specific learning support or extension.</p>	<p>STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM We have a strong student leadership training program where students are introduced to new skills and empowered to be active leaders.. Our students attend a professional conference with up to 2000 other students from across the State.</p>		<p>EI SISTEMA MUSIC PROGRAM Any student in year 3-7 can learn the violin, viola or cello. All children in rec to year 2 learn the recorder. This program is based on research which indicates music is critical in brain development. This program is growing and attracting increased enrolment enquiries.</p>
		<p>SOCIAL SKILLS TRAINING Every student is involved in specific training so they are able to deal with bullying and harassment. Through this we also introduce problem solving strategies and reinforce our high behaviour expectations.</p>

<p>LITERACY SUPPORT Students requiring support in literacy participate in specific programs to strengthen their reading, writing and spelling skills.</p>	<p>SPECIAL CLASS The school hosts a Regional Junior Primary Special class for 8 students with significant learning needs.</p>	<p>COMMUNITY SERVICE Students are encouraged to volunteer their time for community service activities and in turn make a positive difference to their school and their environment.</p>	<p>RECYCLING We conduct an active recycling program and encourage students to engage in sustainable behaviours.</p>
	<p>SHOWCASE ASSEMBLIES Each term we conduct showcase assemblies so students can share their learning. Parents and carers are most welcome to participate as an audience.</p>		
<p>FRIENDSHIP BENCH Our friendship bench is used by children who don't have anyone to play with. By sitting on this bench other children can lend support</p>	<p>CONNECTED SELF We are funded to support students to be engaged in their learning and to promote self-esteem, confidence and self-management practices.</p>	<p>MULTIMEDIA CENTRE We provide training and learning in developing multimedia activities. This includes movie making using clay models.</p>	<p>SECURE GROUNDS Our school has security fencing. Anyone visiting the school must enter through the front office.</p>
