Every student is tested in key
literacy and numeracy areas to
determine strengths and areas for
further development. This
information is used to design
specific learning support or
extension.

## STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

We have a strong student leadership training program where students are introduced to new skills and empowered to be active leaders.. Our students attend a professional conference with up to 2000 other students from across the State.



EI SISTEMA MUSIC PROGRAM Any student in year 3-7 can learn the violin, viola or cello.

All children in rec to year 2 learn the recorder. This program is based on research which indicates music is critical in brain development. This program is growing and attracting increased enrolment enquiries.





SOCIAL SKILLS TRAINING
Every student is involved in specific training so they are able to deal with bullying and harassment. Through this we also introduce problem solving strategies and reinforce our high behaviour expectations.











SPORTING CLINICS
We have strong links with sporting clubs and offer a variety of coaching clinics. Each year the Power and Crows conduct educational programs.

### LITERACY SUPPORT Students requiring support in literacy participate in specific programs to strengthen their reading, writing and spelling skills.



FRIENDSHIP BENCH Our friendship bench is used by children who don't have anyone to play with. By sitting on this bench other children can lend support



**PLAYGROUP ON SITE** We offer a playgroup program for children up to the age of 4. We currently have up to 50 children accessing this program.

**CHRISTIAN PASTORAL SUPPORT** WORKER Our CPSW provides a wonderful support to our students and broader community.

#### LITERACY SUPPORT We access specific assessment tools and programs to support the development of the English language for students who are of a non-English speaking background

### PARENT SUPPORT GROUP Parents come together on a needs basis to share ideas and needs in supporting students with specific learning needs.

STUDENT LEARNING STYLES We identify student learning styles using a multiple intelligences assessment so we can adapt our teaching methods to better suit the strengths of students.

SPECIAL CLASS The school hosts a Regional **Junior Primary Special class for 8** students with significant learning needs.

SHOWCASE ASSEMBLIES Each term we conduct showcase assemblies so students can share their learning. Parents and carers are most welcome to participate as an audience.

CONNECTED SELF We are funded to support students to be engaged in their learning and to promote self-esteem, confidence and self-management practices.

**CO-ORDINATION PROGRAM** 5 year olds are assessed in skills of running, skipping, hopping, balancing so they can participate actively in the playground

PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE 100% achievement.



STUDENT REVIEW TEAM We have regular meeting with support services to monitor students who have specific learning needs.

#### **CLASS GARDENS** Every class has a class garden area for growing fruit, herbs and vegetables with links to the Science curriculum.



**COMMUNITY SERVICE** Students are encouraged to volunteer their time for community service activities and in turn make a positive difference to their school and their environment.



**MULTIMEDIA CENTRE** We provide training and learning in developing multimedia activities. This includes movie making using clay models.



**WONDERFUL FACILITIES** Beautiful shaded playground and garden areas with astro turf playground surfaces and seating for students.



HIGHER ORDER THINKING SKILLS Staff introduce students to explicit thinking tools and strategies to deepen and extend their thinking and learning capacity

JAPANESE SISTER CITY SCHOOL PROGRAM.

We are participating in a state funded program to establish links with Japanese schools.



RECYCLING We conduct an active recycling program and encourage students to engage in sustainable behaviours.



**SECURE GROUNDS** Our school has security fencing. Anyone visiting the school must enter through the front office.



TREES FOR LIFE Ours students are involved with Trees for Life and learn about natural vegetation and propagating plants.



**CURRICULUM CONTINUITY** We have developed and use a curriculum scope and sequence which outlines the specific learning that is intended across the child's learning time at school.
