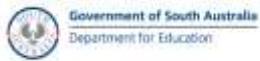

SCHOOL HOLIDAY BREAK

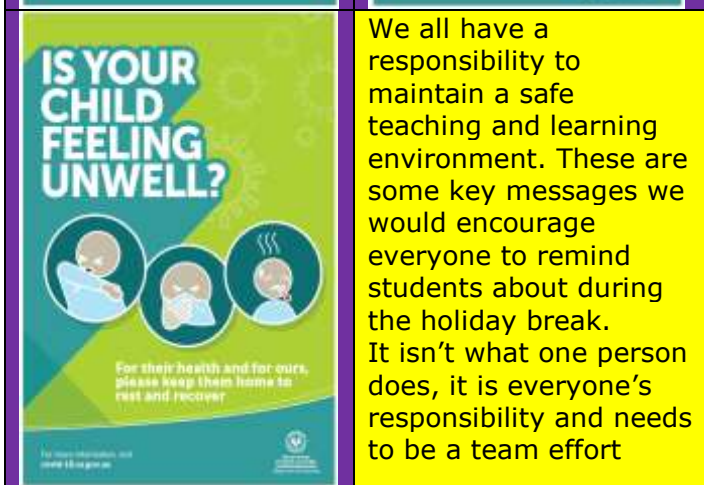
