GOAL FOR 2024 - IMPROVE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT IN WRITING F-6

SUCCESS CRITERIA

YR F- Students will use words and phrases from learning and texts and form letters, and experiment with capital letters and full stops.

YR 1- Students will write simple sentences with sentence boundary punctuation and capital letters for proper nouns and write words using unjoined upper case and lower-case letters

YR 2- Students will punctuate simple and compound sentences and write words using consistently legible unjoined letters

YR 3- Students will use compound sentences accurately with punctuation and use paragraphs.

YR 4- students will use complex sentences with correct punctuation and paragraphs to organise and link ideas

YR 5- students will use complex sentences with correct punctuation and paragraphs to organise, develop and link ideas.

YR 6- Students will use and vary sentence structures and vary paragraphs to organise, develop and link ideas.

TERMS 1 AND 2

ACTION

TERMS 1 AND 3

ACTION

Assessment and goal setting- Brightpath

HOW

- Pre and Post assessments using Brightpath formative assessment tool
- Goal setting and planning based on student data

TERMS 2 AND 4

ACTION

Focus: Language features - sentence level grammar
Focus: Text Structure - Paragraphing

HOW

- Professional development in these areas
- PLC planning - IntialLit or DfE Units of work

TERMS 1, 2, 3 AND 4

ACTION
